

# Conflict Minerals Sourcing Policy

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## 1. Policy Statement

**FZT GmbH & Co. KG** is committed to the responsible sourcing of raw materials. We support the goals of ending the funding of armed conflicts in the Democratic Republic of the Congo and adjoining countries. It is our objective to ensure that the minerals Tin, Tantalum, Tungsten, and Gold (3TG) used in our products do not directly or indirectly finance such conflicts.

## 2. Due Diligence and Transparency

As we procure materials such as brass (e.g., CW614N) which contains tin (Sn) as an alloying element, we commit to performing appropriate due diligence. For this purpose, we utilize the standardized Conflict Minerals Reporting Template (CMRT).

## 3. Requirements for Suppliers

We expect our business partners to:

- Provide full transparency regarding the 3TG minerals in their supply chain.
- Submit a valid CMRT declaration and a Smelter List upon request.
- Source minerals only from smelters that have been certified as "conflict-free" by independent third parties (e.g., RMI).

## 4. Continuous Improvement

**FZT GmbH & Co. KG** regularly reviews the information received from suppliers and works closely with partners to continuously improve supply chain transparency.
